SHS athlete to sign with Sullivan County Community College

Corey Hamula, 18, a 2010 graduate of Southside High School, will sign a letter of intent on Wednesday, July 28 to play baseball for Sullivan County Community College.

Corey was an invaluable member of the SHS baseball program for five years, playing second base during his junior year and shortstop in his senior year. The son of Tom Hamula, Corey received All-STAC West and SHS Baseball Player of the Year awards as a junior. As a senior, Corey batted .354 and led the team with 7 doubles and 2 triples. He also led the team with 23 runs, 10 RBIs and 17 stolen bases.

“Corey’s positive approach and competitive nature towards life will yield him many great things in and out of the classroom. It has been a privilege to know this dedicated student-athlete,” said Jerry Jones, head coach of the SHS varsity baseball team.

Corey will play shortstop and second base during his freshman year at Sullivan County Community College and will major in criminal justice.

As part of the SUNY system, Sullivan County Community College offers 10 intercollegiate sports teams in men and women’s basketball, cross country, golf, outdoor track, cheerleading and men’s baseball. The college’s sports teams are called the Generals.

Sullivan County Community College competes at the NJCAA Division II level and is a part of Region XV for baseball. In 2008, the baseball team won the NJCAA Region XV championship, marking the first baseball championship in the college’s history. The team’s head coach is Ryan Snair.
