Upcoming free clinics for school immunizations

The Chemung County Health Department at 103 Washington St., Elmira is offering extra clinics for school immunizations. These clinics will provide only vaccinations required for school attendance and not elective immunizations such as flu shots.

In addition to the health department's regular immunization clinics held from 1-3:30 p.m. on the first and third Tuesdays of each month and from 6-8:30 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday of the month, the following dates and times are announced:

- Tuesday, Aug. 25: 1-3:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, Sept. 1: 1-3:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, Sept. 8: 1-3:30 p.m.
- Tuesday Sept. 15: 1-3:30 p.m.

New York State public health law states that starting Sept. 23, students whose vaccinations are not up to date will not be allowed to attend school until they bring proof of immunizations to the school nurse. The only exception will be those students who moved to the district over the summer, who will have until Oct. 9 to receive immunizations.

All required school vaccinations are free, and no appointments are necessary. For more information, call the health department at (607) 737-2028.
