# Win-Win Discipline: The Book

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Did you know that in your building there are *Win-Win Discipline* (Kagan Publishing, 2004) books available for you to check out? Every school building within the Elmira City School District has these books available to anyone who wants to borrow one. You can find them either with your IST or in the teacher resource section of your media center.

The book is an awesome resource. The way it's formatted makes it easy to find what you need, when you need it. In the first pages, right after the Table of Contents, the page numbers are given for preventative procedures for both the ABCD Disruptions and the Seven Positions. They are grouped by type of disruption and for each position so that you don't have to search through pages to find what you need.

In addition, there are tables containing the page numbers for

the Moment of Disruption structures and strategies. These are also formatted for ease of use.

*Win-Win Discipline* isn't just a resource for teachers who are experiencing disruption in the classroom.

It's a great resource for any teacher who wants to create the kind of classroom we all want and need (interesting, fun, positive, productive, caring, orderly).

In addition to the preventative procedures, moment of disruption structures and strategies, and the follow-up structures,

there are specific ideas for students with special needs. There is a chapter on classroom management, one on instruction, and one on life skills. There are also three pages from *Silly Sports & Goofy Games* (another great Kagan book). It might be worth taking a look.
