



Elmira City Schools Family Health Sick Care Clinic at Beecher Elementary School NOW OPEN AND SEEING STUDENTS

- WHO:** The Clinic is open to all Elmira City School District students.
- WHERE:** Beecher Elem. Sch., 310 Sullivan St. Elmira
- PH#:** School Office – 735-3501
- WHEN:** Each Wednesday school is in session
- TIME:** 1:00PM – 3:00PM
- SERVICES:** Basic illness and injury care – no stitches, casts/splints, etc. – can provide rapid strep tests
- Sprains and strains
 - Cold and flu
 - Earache
 - Asthma
 - Skin rashes and Pink-eye: for diagnosis of cause, treatment, and clearance to return to school
 - Ill child – usual healthcare provider not available, family has no regular provider, or parent does not have transportation to usual provider
 - Chronic/recurrent head lice
 - Evaluation of possible concussion – with gym / sports excuse if needed
 - Healthcare navigator to assist families with insurance issues, help them find a medical home, etc. – “undoctored” patients will be directed to Primary Care and/or Family Medicine physicians.
 - All services provided at no charge
 - This is not a well care clinic – athletic physicals may be offered periodically but are not a regular service of the clinic.
- NOTE:** Immunizations are not given at the clinic.
