2020-2021 PROPOSED BUDGET

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REVENUES

School Districts receive money from several sources. These sources are:

- STATE AID The budget is based on the State's 2020-21 budget. State aid for the 2020-21 budget year is expected to be \$1,581,035 more when compared to the 2019-20 budget.
- OTHER INCOME Any income received by the School District other than State Aid, Fund Balance or Tax Levy is included under this heading. Examples of other income would be; BOCES revenue, interest earnings, sales of property and equipment, refunds of prior year's expenses, gifts, rentals, fees, tuition, and Medicaid reimbursements.
 - 3. <u>**RESERVES**</u> The District maintains Reserve Funds established in accordance with guidelines established by the Comptroller of the State of New York.
 - 4. **FUND BALANCE** Funds which are budgeted but unexpended at the end of a budget year, and revenues which are realized in excess of those budgeted for the year, are available at the end of one fiscal year to be carried forward as fund balance.
 - 5. <u>TAX LEVY</u> This is the amount to be raised through local property taxes. The Board of Education desires to keep any increase in the levy as low as possible. For the 2020-21 school year, there will be a 2% increase to the tax levy set by the Board of Education in September 2020 for the 2020-21 school year.

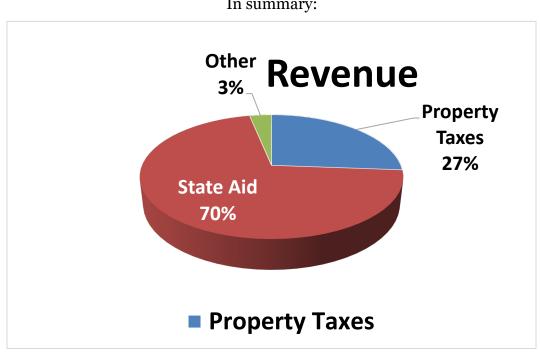

SUMMARY 2020-21 GENERAL FUND REVENUES

The two main sources of revenue are the local tax levy and aid from the State of New York. For a number of years, the State has provided about 70 percent of the total district revenues. This year the estimated amount of aid totals \$93,169,795. This means that the local taxpayer will be paying approximately 27 percent of the district expense, while the State's contribution is 70 percent. Other local projected revenues of \$4,143,000 will also be committed to fund the new budget. This other revenue and fund balance represents 3.0 percent of the budget.

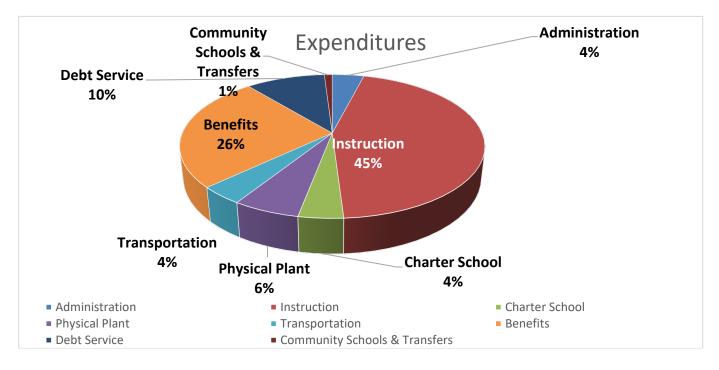

Proposition #1:

APPROVAL OF BUDGET

Shall the following resolution be adopted?

RESOLVED, that the proposed \$133,322,023 General Fund Budget of the Elmira City School District, Chemung County, New York for 2020-21 be approved in accordance with Section 2022 of the Education Law and that the balance of said budget, after applying public monies thereto, be raised by a tax upon the taxable property of said district.

Proposition #2:

CAPITAL AND ENERGY PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, 2020

Shall the following bond resolution of the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Elmira be approved, to-wit:

A BOND RESOLUTION, DATED MARCH 18, 2020, OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF ELMIRA, CHEMUNG COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE "DISTRICT"), AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO (A)(1) UNDERTAKE (SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE VOTERS OF THE DISTRICT) A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT CONSISTING PRIMARILY OF THE RECONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION, IN PART, AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AND UPGRADES TO, VARIOUS DISTRICT BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES (AND THE SITES THEREOF), ALL AT A MAXIMUM ESTIMATED AGGREGATE COST OF \$68,000,000 (THE "CAPITAL PROJECT"); (2) EXPEND TOWARD THE PROJECT UP TO \$7,000,000 OF THE DISTRICT'S 2015 CAPITAL RESERVE FUND AND UP TO \$7,000,000 OF THE DISTRICT'S 2019 CAPITAL RESERVE FUND; AND (3) ISSUE SERIAL BONDS OF THE DISTRICT IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,000,000 TO FINANCE THE BALANCE OF THE COST OF THE CAPITAL PROJECT, WITH SUCH AMOUNT TO BE OFFSET BY ANY FEDERAL, STATE, COUNTY AND/OR LOCAL FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE DISTRICT FOR THE CAPITAL PROJECT, INCLUDING THE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE CONTRACT WITH UNISYS CORPORATION; (B) DELEGATE THE POWER TO ISSUE BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE SALE OF SUCH BONDS TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE DISTRICT; AND (C) UNDERTAKE AN ENERGY PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO ALLOW THE DISTRICT (SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE VOTERS OF THE DISTRICT) TO RECEIVE AN EXTRA 10% MEASURE OF BUILDING AID FROM THE STATE OF NEW YORK FOR SUCH ENERGY PERFORMANCE PROJECT GOING FORWARD IN ORDER TO MAXIMIZE THE DISTRICT'S RECEIPT OF BUILDING AID FROM THE STATE OF NEW YORK, ALL AT A MAXIMUM ESTIMATED AGGREGATE COST OF \$8,750,000 (THE "EPC PROJECT"). be approved?

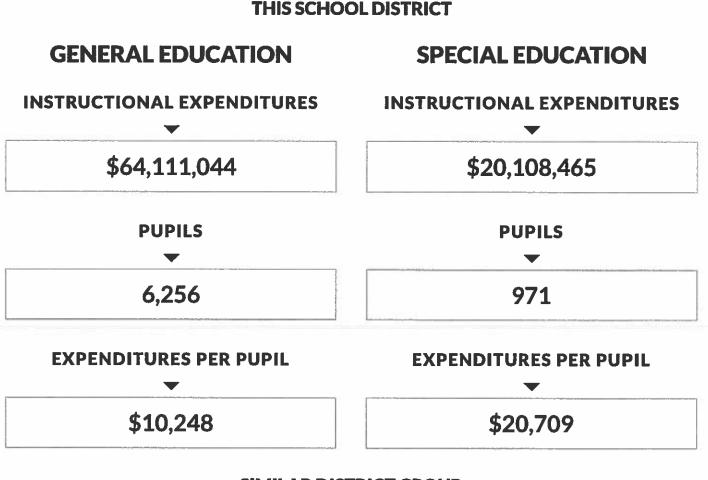

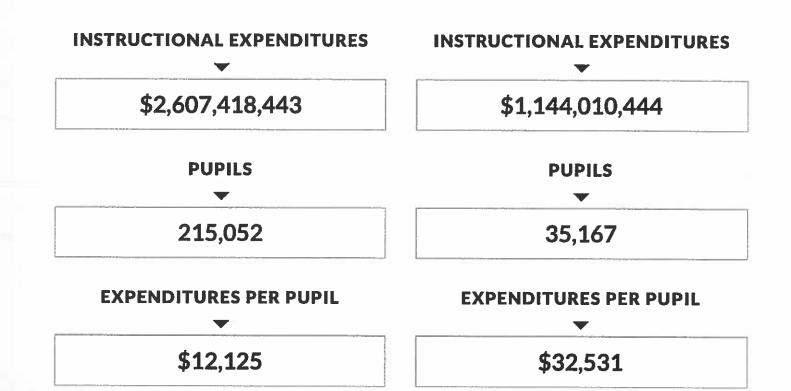

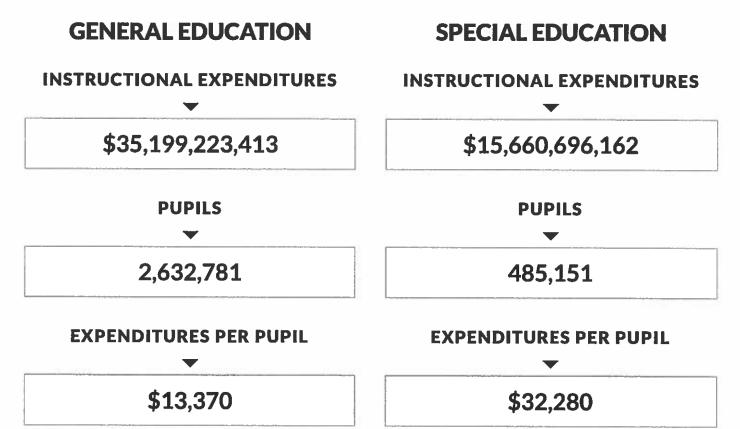
SIMILAR DISTRICT GROUP HIGH NEED/RESOURCE CAPACITY URBAN OR SUBURBAN

Instructional Expenditures for General Education are K-12 expenditures for classroom instruction (excluding Special Education) plus a proration of building level administrative and instructional support expenditures. These expenditures include amounts for instruction of students with disabilities in a general-education setting. District expenditures, such as transportation, debt service and district-wide administration are not included.

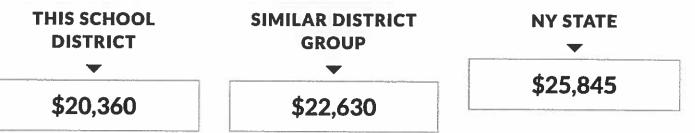
The pupil count for General Education is K-12 average daily membership plus K-12 pupils for whom the district pays tuition to another school district. This number represents all pupils, including those classified as having disabilities and those not classified, excluding only students with disabilities placed out of district. Pupils resident in the district but attending a charter school are included. For districts in which a county jail is located, this number includes incarcerated youth to whom the district must provide an education program.

Instructional Expenditures for Special Education are K-12 expenditures for students with disabilities (including summer special education expenditures) plus a proration of buildinglevel administrative and instructional support expenditures. District expenditures, such as transportation, debt service and district-wide administration are not included.

The pupil count for Special Education is a count of K-12 students with disabilities for the school year plus students for whom the district receives tuition from another district plus students for whom the district pays tuition to another district. Students attending the State schools at Rome and Batavia, private placements and out-of-state placements are included.

Instructional Expenditures Per Pupil is the simple arithmetic ratio of Instructional Expenditures to Pupils. The total cost of instruction for students with disabilities may include both general- and special-education expenditures. Special-education services provided in the general-education classroom may benefit students not classified as having disabilities.

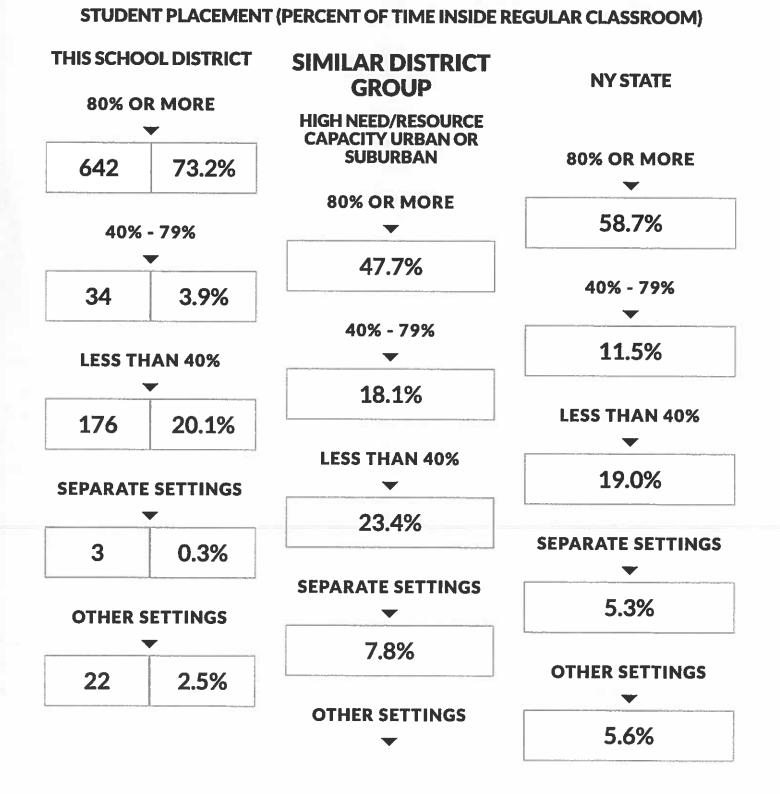
TOTAL EXPENDITURES PER PUPIL



Total Expenditures Per Pupil is the simple arithmetic ratio of Total Expenditures to Pupils. Total Expenditures include district expenditures for classroom instruction, as well as expenditures for transportation, debt service, community service and district-wide administration that are not included in the Instructional Expenditure values for General Education and Special Education. As such, the sum of General Education and Special Education Instructional Expenditures does not equal the Total Expenditures.

INFORMATION ABOUT STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (2018 - 19)

Commissioner's Regulations require reporting students with disabilities by the percent of time they are in general education classrooms and the classification rate of students with disabilities. These data are to be compared with percentages for similar districts and all public schools. The required percentages for this district are reported below.

The source data for the statistics in this table were reported through the Student Information Repository System (SIRS) and verified in Verification Report 5. The counts are numbers of students reported in the least restrictive environment categories for school-age programs (ages 6-21) on BEDS Day, which is the first Wednesday of the reporting year. The percentages represent the amount of time students with disabilities are in general-education classrooms, regardless of the amount and cost of special-education services they receive. Rounding of percentage values may cause them to sum to a number slightly different from 100%.

This rate is a ratio of the count of school-age students with disabilities (ages 4-21) to the total enrollment of all school-age students in the school district, including students who are parentally placed in nonpublic schools located in the school district. The numerator includes all school-age students for whom a district has Committee on Special Education (CSE) responsibility to ensure the provision of special-education services. The denominator includes all school-age students who reside in the district. In the case of parentally placed students in nonpublic schools, it includes the number of students who attend the nonpublic schools located in the school district. Source data are drawn from the SIRS and from the Basic Education Data System (BEDS).

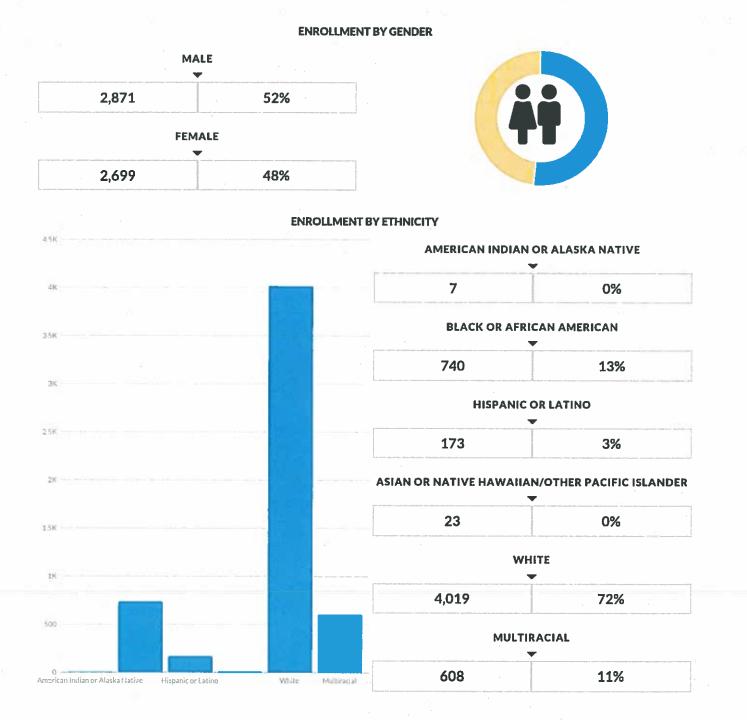

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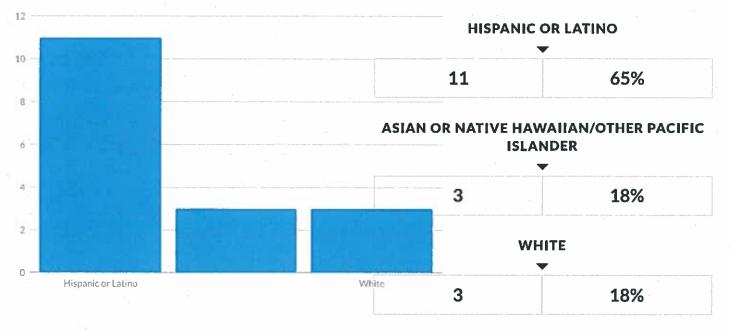
ELMIRA CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS ENROLLMENT (2018 - 19)

ELL ENROLLMENT BY GENDER



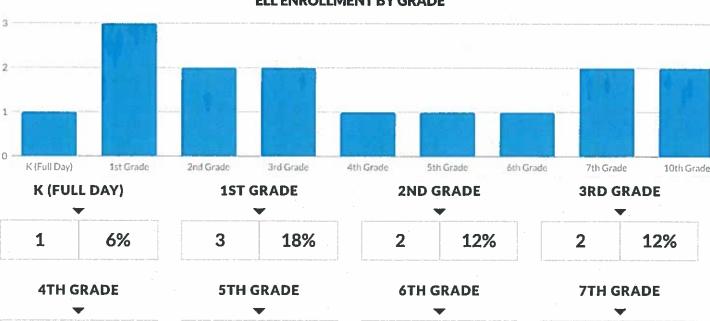


ELL ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY

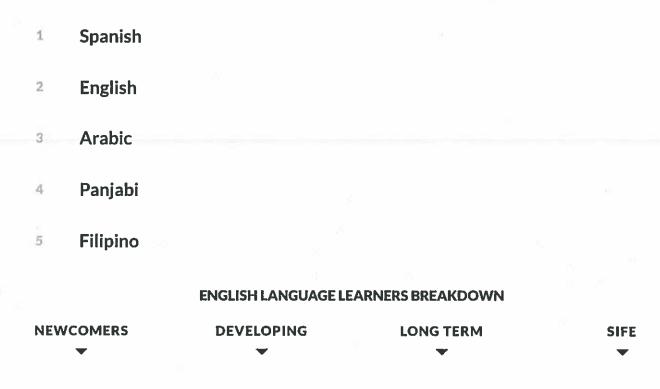

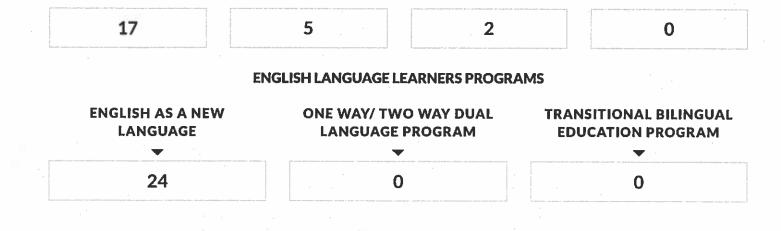

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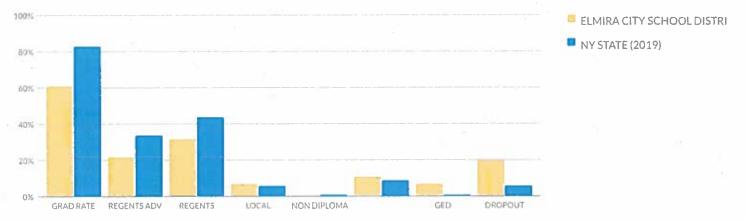

The recently approved regulations recognize the importance of engaging students' interests in rigorous and relevant academic programs in the Arts; Languages other than English (LOTE)/Biliteracy; Career and Technical Education (CTE); Humanities; Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM); and Career Developmental Occupational Studies (CDOS). The revised regulation allows students to use a passing score on an approved pathway assessment or successful completion of program requirements for the CDOS credential toward meeting the assessment requirements for graduation.
