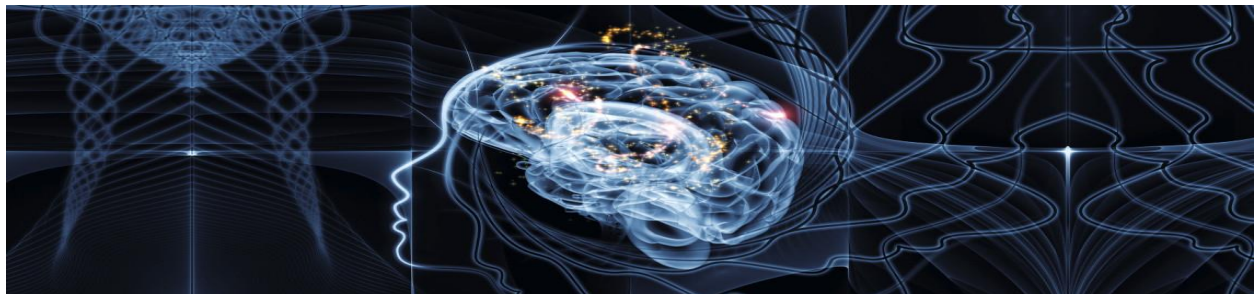
First Year Experience (FYEX)

Introduction to Psychological Science

PSYC 1101 – 3 credits

An introduction to psychology. Includes scientific method, measurement in psychology, motivation, learning, thinking and problem solving. Perception, behavior disorders and varieties of treatment, biological basis of behavior, social determinants of behavior, human development and personality. Prerequisite: Eligible to take ENGL 1010. Lectures, demonstrations, discussions and field assignments. Meets SUNY General Education requirement in Social Sciences. This class offering is hybrid – partially in-person and partially remote-virtual.
